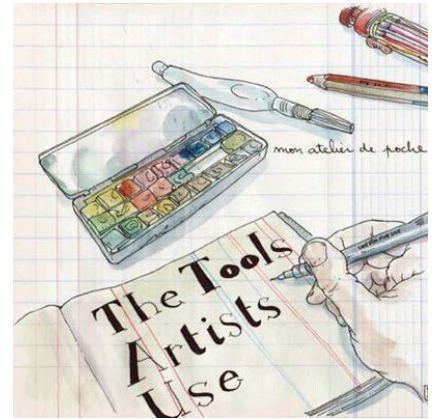
# WORKSHOP SCHEDULE

Wednesday, August 1, 1:30-3:00

6-8 year-olds

10:30-12:00 (for 6-8 year-olds) and 1:30-3:00 for (9-12 year-olds)

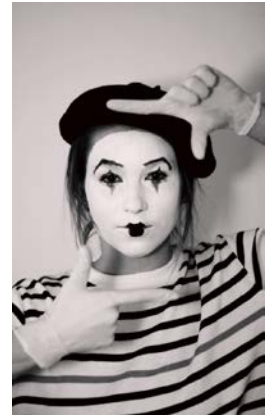
